CHAPTER 1

Purchasing the App

Camper is available for a one-time payment — no subscriptions, no hidden costs. After purchase you receive a license key and download link by email.

How to Buy

- 1 Visit mojavtodom.me2d.si/en and click the **Buy now** button.
- 2 A secure checkout powered by **Polar.sh** opens. Enter your email address and payment details.
- 3 If you have a discount code, enter it in the **Promo code** field before confirming payment.
- 4 After successful payment you receive an **email with your license key** and a link to download the installer.
- 5 **Save your license key** in a safe place — you will need it during the first launch of the app.

Current promotion: Enter code **START5** at checkout to receive a 5% discount. The code is displayed at the top of the website.

CHAPTER 2

Installation

The app is installed using a Windows installer (.exe). The process takes less than a minute.

System Requirements

REQUIREMENT	MINIMUM
Operating System	Windows 10 or Windows 11 (64-bit)
Memory (RAM)	4 GB
Disk Space	~150 MB
Internet Connection	Required only for activation. Works fully offline after that.

Step-by-Step Installation

- 1 Download the installer file **Camper_setup_1.9.exe** from the link in your email.
- 2 Double-click the downloaded file. Windows SmartScreen may show a warning — this is normal for newly released software.
- 3 Click **More info** → **Run anyway**. The app is safe — the warning appears because the app does not yet have an expensive digital certificate.
- 4 Follow the installation wizard. The default folder is `C:\Program Files\Camper`.
- 5 After installation a **Camper** shortcut appears on your desktop. Double-click it to launch the app.

Your data is safe: The app stores all data locally on your computer in the `Documents\Camper` folder. Nothing is uploaded to any server.

CHAPTER 3

License Activation

On first launch the app asks for your license key. Once activated, the app works completely offline — forever.

Activation Steps

- 1 On first launch an activation window appears asking for your **license key**.
- 2 Open the email you received after purchase and copy your license key (format: `XXXX-XXXX-XXXX`).
- 3 Paste the key into the field and click **Activate**. An internet connection is required for this step.
- 4 After successful activation the full app opens. The key is saved — you only enter it once.

Activation failing? Check your internet connection. Make sure the key is pasted exactly, with no extra spaces. If the problem persists, contact info@me2d.si.

Managing Your License (in Settings)

You can view your license details at any time under **Settings** → **License**:

- Activation status (activated / not activated)
- License key (partially hidden for security)
- Activation date

CHAPTER 4

Home — Dashboard

The home screen gives you an instant overview of your trips, key statistics, and upcoming planned adventures.

Statistics Cards

The top row shows key totals across everything you have entered:

CARD	WHAT IT SHOWS
Trips	Total number of trips logged
Total km	Sum of all trip distances
Countries visited	Number of unique countries across all trips
Days on the road	Total duration of all trips in days
Total fuel	Litres refuelled from your fuel log
Fuel cost	Total spent on fuel in € (or your chosen currency)
Avg. consumption	Average fuel consumption in L/100 km
Cost/km	Average fuel cost per kilometre

Tip: Click any statistics card to expand a detailed chart for that category directly below the cards.

Planned Trips

Top right shows trips with status **Planned** — future adventures you haven't set off on yet.

Recent Trips

Below is a list of your 5 most recent completed trips. Click any trip to open it and view the full details.

CHAPTER 5

Trips

The heart of the app — log every motorhome adventure with full details about the route, campsites, expenses and daily stages.

Trip List

The **Trips** page shows all your trips. The toolbar at the top lets you search and filter:

- **Search:** search by trip title or location
- **Year:** filter trips by year
- **Country:** filter by country visited
- **Sort:** by date (newest/oldest), kilometres, nights or title

Each trip card shows: title, dates, total kilometres, duration and number of nights.

Trip Statuses

Planned A future trip you haven't departed on yet.

In progress A trip currently underway.

Completed A finished trip.

CHAPTER 5.1

Adding a New Trip

Click the + **New trip** button in the top-right corner of the Trips page.

Basic Details

FIELD	STATUS	DESCRIPTION
Trip title	Required	A descriptive name, e.g. <i>Easter road trip to the Alps</i>
Departure date	Optional	Date the trip started
Return date	Optional	Date the trip ended
Departure location	Optional	Starting point, e.g. <i>Manchester</i>
Destination	Optional	Main destination or end point
Total km	Optional	Total distance of the trip in kilometres
Odometer start	Optional	Odometer reading at departure (km)
Odometer end	Optional	Odometer reading on return (km)
Drive time	Optional	Total driving time — enter hours/minutes or use the time picker
Cover photo	Optional	A photo from the trip
Countries visited	Optional	Select one or more countries
Notes	Optional	Free-text description, highlights, impressions

Advanced Entry

Click the **Advanced entry** button at the bottom of the form to reveal three extra sections: **Camps**, **Expenses** and **Stages**. These are hidden by default to keep the basic form simple and fast.

Tip: If an existing trip already has camps, expenses or stages saved, the advanced section expands automatically when you open it.

CHAPTER 5.2

Stages & Odometer Tracking

Break a longer trip into individual daily stages. The app automatically calculates total kilometres from your stages.

Adding a Stage

In the **Stages** section click + **Add stage**. Each stage contains:

FIELD	DESCRIPTION
Stage description	E.g. <i>Dover → Calais</i>
Distance (km)	Kilometres for this stage
Odometer start	Odometer reading before this stage
Odometer end	Odometer reading after this stage
Date	Date of this stage

Automatic Odometer Tracking

The **Link odo** toggle in the **Stages** section header, when enabled, automatically:

- chains odometer values across stages (end of one stage becomes start of the next),
- calculates the trip's return odometer from the last stage.

The **Recalculate from stages** button manually updates the trip's total km and odometer from the stages you have entered.

CHAPTER 5.3

Camps & Overnight Stays

Use the **Camps** section to record where you spent the night. Click + **Add camp**.

FIELD	STATUS	DESCRIPTION
Camp / site name	Optional	E.g. <i>Camping International Nice</i>
Address	Optional	Street and town
Arrival date	Optional	When you arrived at the site
Departure date	Optional	When you left the site
Nightly cost	Optional	Price per night
Notes	Optional	Your rating, description of the site

Tip: You can also log wild camping spots — just enter the location without a cost.

CHAPTER 5.4

Expenses

Record all spending during a trip (tolls, restaurants, tourist attractions...) in the **Expenses** section. Click + **Add expense**.

FIELD	STATUS	DESCRIPTION
Description	Required	Short label, e.g. <i>Austrian motorway vignette</i>
Amount	Required	The cost
Currency	Optional	€, £, \$, ... (defaults to your settings)
Date	Optional	Date of the expense
Category	Optional	Food, Accommodation, Transport, Entertainment, Other

The total of all expenses for a trip is shown on its card in the trip list.

CHAPTER 6

Fuel

The fuel log records every fill-up. The app automatically calculates consumption and total costs.

Fuel Overview

The top of the page shows three summary cards: **Total litres**, **Total cost** and **Avg. €/L**. Below is a list of all your recorded fill-ups.

Adding a Fill-Up

Click + **Add fill-up** (bottom-right corner). The form contains:

FIELD	STATUS	DESCRIPTION
Date	Required	Date of the fill-up
Trip	Optional	Link this fill-up to a trip for accurate cost analysis
Country	Optional	Where you refuelled — useful for comparing prices by country
Location / station	Optional	E.g. <i>Shell Motorway Services M6</i>
Litres	Required	Amount of fuel added
Price per litre	Optional	Cost of one litre
Currency	Optional	Defaults to €, can be changed
Total cost	Optional	Auto-calculated from litres × price/L
Odometer (km)	Optional	Odometer reading at fill-up — used to calculate consumption
Notes	Optional	Free text

Tip: When you enter price per litre and litres, the total cost is calculated automatically. You can also edit it manually.

CHAPTER 7

Calendar

A full-year overview of all your trips on one page — see at a glance which days you were on the road.

What It Shows

The Calendar page displays a **full-year view** (all months at once). Days when you were on a trip are highlighted in colour. The colour indicates which trip that day belongs to.

Click a highlighted day to see a short summary of the trip on that date.

Navigation

Use the ← / → buttons to move between years. The app shows all years for which you have at least one trip.

CHAPTER 8

Statistics

Interactive charts and in-depth analysis of your trips, fuel consumption and costs.

Statistics Cards

The same cards as on the Home screen appear at the top, but here clicking them expands a detailed chart inline.

Charts — Trips

CHART	DESCRIPTION
Trips by year	Bar chart — how many trips you took each year
Kilometres by year	Total trip distance per year
Countries visited	Pie chart — share of kilometres per country
Days on the road	Total trip duration by month or year

Charts — Fuel

CHART	DESCRIPTION
Consumption by month	Total litres refuelled per month
Cost by country	Comparison of fuel costs by country of fill-up
Cost / km	Fuel cost per kilometre trend over time

Tip: Clicking a bar or segment in a chart shows the detailed list of trips for that period or category.

CHAPTER 9

Settings

Settings holds your vehicle details, app preferences and license information.

Vehicle Details

SETTING	DESCRIPTION
Vehicle name	Your motorhome's display name, e.g. <i>Our little home</i>
Registration plate	For your own reference
Year	Year the vehicle was manufactured
Tank size (L)	Fuel tank capacity — used to estimate range to next fill-up
Consumption (L/100km)	Your average fuel consumption — used to estimate costs
Currency	Default currency for expenses and fuel entries
Odometer (km)	Current odometer reading of your vehicle

Appearance

The app supports both **dark** and **light** themes. Switch using the buttons in the bottom-left corner of the sidebar or within Settings.

Data Folder

By default data is stored in Documents\Camper. In Settings you can choose any other folder — useful for storing data on an external drive or a synced folder (Dropbox, OneDrive).

License

The **License** section shows your activation status and license key. A **Check for updates** button is also available here for manually checking for new versions.

CHAPTER 10

Improvements

Use the Improvements section to send us suggestions, ideas or bug reports. Your feedback directly shapes the future of the app.

Submitting a Suggestion

- 1 Click **Improvements** in the sidebar.

- 2 Select a **category**: New feature, Improvement, Bug report, Usability or Other.

- 3 Describe your idea in the **Your suggestion or idea** field.

- 4 Optionally enter your name and email if you would like a reply from the developers.

- 5 Click **Send suggestion**.

Thank you: We read every suggestion and use them when planning future updates. The best ideas make it into the next version. **Keep an eye on app updates!**

CHAPTER 11

App Updates

The app automatically checks for a new version on launch. When an update is available, a small **amber dot** appears in the bottom-left corner next to the version number.

Installing an Update

- 1 When you see the dot, click the version number or go to **Settings** → **License**.
- 2 Click **Check for updates**, then **Download & install**.
- 3 The app downloads the new installer and launches it automatically. Follow the installation wizard.

Your data is safe: Updates never delete your data. Trips, fuel entries and settings remain untouched.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need an internet connection while using the app?

No. Internet is only required for the **initial license activation** and for **checking updates**. All other features work fully offline.

Where is my data stored?

All data is stored **locally on your computer** in the Documents\Camper folder (or whichever folder you set in Settings). Nothing is uploaded to any server.

Can I install the app on a new computer?

One license key covers one installation. If you replace your computer, email info@me2d.si to have your license transferred.

How do I move my data to a new computer?

Copy the contents of Documents\Camper (or your custom data folder) to the new computer. After installing and activating the app on the new machine, point the data folder to that same path in Settings.

Why does Windows SmartScreen warn me during installation?

SmartScreen flags all newly released software that doesn't carry an expensive digital certificate. The app is safe. Click **More info** → **Run anyway**.

Is the app available for Mac or Linux?

The app is currently available for **Windows 10 and 11 (64-bit) only**.

What happens to my data if I uninstall the app?

Data files are not part of the installer and are **not deleted** when you uninstall. They remain in the Documents\Camper folder.

Are updates paid?

No. All updates are **free** for licence holders and included in the one-time purchase price.
